Service and PAA

As our fellowship keeps growing each year, we have found that one of the best ways to maintain sobriety and to help carry the message to the still suffering porn addict is to have a service position.

Service positions can be at the local group level, such as secretary, treasurer, coffee maker. Group Service Representatives represent each group at the monthly General Service Conference and report back to their local group at the monthly business meeting.

Positions are 6 months, one year and in some cases, for the purposes of continuity, two years, such as the GSR. Each group can determine what length of time is needed through the group conscience.

While we do not yet have a regional structure, we do have a global structure that has taken shape over the past five years.

As our traditions state, we have service committees and service boards that are directly responsible to those they serve.

Out of our General Service Conference, we have elected the following committees: 501c3, Literature, Website, Finance, and we may create others as our fellowship needs.

We welcome all groups to elect GSRs so that all members are involved with our overall process of growth.
